Utilizing their MA Bureau of Substance Addiction Services grant, GLFHC commissioned Mandela Yoga to adapt its intervention to meet the needs of recently-released, Spanish-speaking men of color at risk of fatal overdoses upon release from incarceration.

2022

Reentry Services Unit:

Piloted the Mandela Yoga intervention with patients for 13 months in Spanish - with treatment adherence of greater than 80%



Integrative Health Unit:

Introduced the Mandela Yoga intervention in Spanish to patients in Prenatal and Metabolic Group Medical Visits with Suhani Bora, MD.



Integrative Health Unit:

Piloted the Mandela Yoga intervention for 12 weeks in Spanish with patients in clinic's.

In Spanish, trained two clinic staff and seven formerly incarcerated men of color to be Mandela Yoga Peer Facilitators.
